

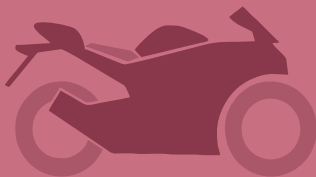


Automotive Sector



Indian automotive industry is one of the largest in the world accounting for **7.1 per cent** of the country's **Gross Domestic Product (GDP)**

The **Two Wheelers segment**, with **80 per cent market share**, is the leader of the Indian Automobile market owing to a growing middle class and a young population



25 million automobiles produced in FY17 with total production volume growing at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of **5.56 per cent** between FY12-17

India is poised to **employ nearly 15 million** people in the sector by **2022** with **3.44 million** to be engaged in the service sector



The sector has the potential to generate up to **USD 300 billion** in annual revenue by 2026
