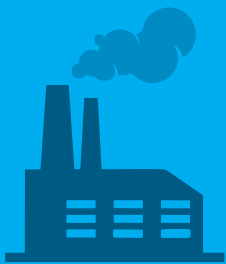

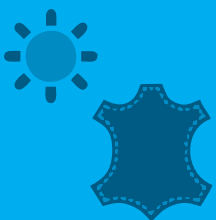
2nd Ranking for India in terms of **leather footwear and goods & garments production** in the world
